Other Programmes

Title:	Leadership Training of Student Guidance Service Group
Deliverables:	1. Big Brothers can develop their confidence by giving guidance to F.2 students, especially on studies 2. Big Brothers can enhance their leadership and counselling skills
Target:	25-30 F.4 to F.5 students
Selection mechanism:	Nominated by moderators
Duration and venue:	4 workshops and evaluation meetings from Sep 2023 to Mar 2024
Evaluation:	The leadership training was provided by the Pupil Ambassador Scheme on Positive Learning (provided by a social worker from Baptist Oi Kwan Social Service) for all the 8 big brothers and was free-of-charge.

Title:	History Elite Training Programme
Deliverables:	Students learn reading and high-order thinking skills through sharing and discussion sessions, as well as writing reflective essays.
Target:	F.4-F.5 History students
Selection mechanism:	Nominated by the History panel
Duration and venue:	6 sessions were held from Oct 2023 to May 2024
Evaluation:	14 F.4-F.5 Students from the History class enjoyed doing research based on the selected books and worked well in groups. Comprehensive learning skills could be enhanced by completing both the presentations and reflective essays.
Expenditure:	\$0

Title:	Mathematics School Team Training
Deliverables:	Students learn Mathematics problem solving skills and apply them in Mathematics competitions.
Target:	12 F.4 to F.6 students

Selection mechanism:	Nominated by Mathematics teachers
Duration and venue:	Training (1.5 hours each lesson) was held before each competition from Oct 2023 to May 2024.
Evaluation:	Two 2 nd Honour Class awards in the Hong Kong Youth Mathematical High Achievers Selection Contest, One 3 rd class honour award in the Hong Kong Mathematics Olympiad. The results were less satisfactory than the previous year.
Expenditure:	\$3500

Title:	Helping Elite students to unleash their potentials
Deliverables:	1. Joining Student Leadership Taster Programmes organized by the HKFYG Leadership Institute 2. Joining Dual Programmes organised by HKUST
Target:	F.4-F.5 students
Selection mechanism:	Nominated by teachers
Duration and venue:	Lessons throughout the year
Evaluation:	➤ 1 F.6 student completed a 17th Genetic Engineering Training Programme (DNA Stream) ➤ 8 F.4-5 students participated in HKUST Dual Program and obtained grade B or above. ➤ The project is considered as successful.
Expenditure:	\$25050

Title:	Subsidy for one F.4 students and two F.5 students and one F.6 student to attend DSE PE lessons
Deliverables:	The student could acquire the knowledge and exam skills
Target:	1 F.4 students, 2 F.5 students and 1 F.6 student
Selection mechanism:	Nominated by teachers
Duration and venue:	1. 3 hours every Saturday in the first term and the second term 2. Attend lessons in Lai King
Evaluation:	95% attendance. The results were extremely good. These students also helped organize some trainings for the schoolmates.
Expenditure:	\$ 32000

Deliverables:	The student could acquire the knowledge and exam skills for Cambridge Japanese Exam which is counted as a DSE elective
Target:	8 F.6 students
Selection mechanism:	Application from students
Duration and venue:	1. 3 hours every Saturday until the public exam in October 2. Attend lessons in Kowloon and Hong Kong Island at Academy of the Baptist Convention of Hong Kong
Evaluation:	-80 % attendance. -The public exam results were good. 3 students got A
Expenditure:	\$34400
