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校長採訪-品德教育

相信每位進入觀瑪校園的觀瑪仔都會 接觸到四個重要的價值:尊重 (Respect)、責任(Responsibility),及在 正確的時間做正確的事(Do the Right Thing at the Right Time)。這四個原則 不僅旨在培養學生的品德,也是本年 度校報專訪校長的中心主題。

#### 校長能否分享觀瑪對於品德教育的核心理念?

#### 學校在這方面有哪些具體政策和措施? 冼校長有何見解?

學校的措施當然不少,例如每個星期一的周會,不同的組別如宗教組、輔導 組、訓導組、公民教育組等,會作出不同主題的分享。此外,天主教的五大核 心價值也建立了學校的氛圍,加上學校的六個校訓,這些都為學校建立了穩固 的德育教育框架。

不過,我認為教師與學生之間的互動至關重要。我時常會問學生,學校和補習 社有何分別?很多同學會回答說,上學是為求學習書本上的知識。對我來說, 學校更重要的角色,是讓學生學習待人接物、人際交往和道德規範等社會微觀 的重要基地。因此,如何在學校裡灌輸正確的道德觀,我相信關鍵在於老師本 身。在我的成長過程中,遇過很多優秀的老師。他們對我的價值觀、對我如何 思考以及如何做出決定,都有著非常深遠的影響。讀書可以靠自己努力,但在 處世和與別人交往的事情上,必須有一些活生生的「Role Model」的影響下才能 學到。因此, 最終老師作為模範作用是不可或缺的, 因為學生會模仿老師的行 為和價值觀。

何俊邦老師曾提到,不同的學校有各自的校規。然而,為何觀瑪的校規會呈現 現今的樣貌呢?這是因為我們秉持著信任學生的理念,並融入天主教教育的精 神--寬恕、包容與愛。我們需要這樣的框架與架構,才能建立現行的校規。雖 然增加更多校規是可行的,但我認為這未必恰當,同時亦不能符合我們學校的 運作方式。

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有甚麼回應? 社交媒體已成為一種無法逆轉的社會現 象。對當代學生來說,處理來自社交媒體

的壓力是一大挑戰。學校並不會禁止學生 使用社交媒體、但我們會持續教育同學、

強調每次發言都應具有意義,避免無責任和傷害他人的言論。這是學生學習負

責任表達和社會交往的重要部分。

當今社會,人們普遍透過社交媒體表達意見,或尋求他人的認同與讚賞。我認 為這是一種顯著的社會現象。回想數十年前,當我年輕時,根本不需要面對這 樣的情況。當時的生活沒有社交媒體,每天接觸最多的只是電視, 但其即時性 遠不如現今,尋求他人回應的機會也相對有限。而如今,每個人都能成為記 者、錄音師,甚至評論者,隨時發表觀點並影響他人。因此,應對社交媒體所 帶來的變化與挑戰,確實變得更加困難。

每個時代都面臨新的挑戰,我認為社交媒體的發明確實帶來了許多便利與機 會。然而,同時它也帶來了不同形式的壓力。對於年輕人而言,除了學業與社 交上的壓力, 媒體所傳遞的信息與影響也成為另一種負擔。

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我相信「Special Assembly」在過去也曾存在,只是最近兩次的主題都與不當使用 社交媒體有關。這些議題確實值得關注,因為許多人可能在初期並未意識到其 中潛藏的風險與問題。我們可以透過「Special Assembly」作為一個契機,提醒同 學需留意自身在社交媒體上的行為與影響。這並非壞事,因為每個人都有不同 的面向,而了解並善用這些工具,才能更負責任地應對數位時代的挑戰。

#### 於政策上,學校會否考慮為此而作出改變?

我相信不斷的提醒是必要的,因為人總是需要被提醒與引導。然而,關於學校 政策是否會因此改變,我認為學校並不會禁止學生在社交媒體上發表言論,這 絕不是我們或任何人希望做的事。

學校的老師們在這裡工作多年,深知這所學校的氛 圍與辦學理念,因此不會透過政策來限制學生的發 聲權利。相反,我們會教育學生,在發表意見時, 必須確保自己的言論是有意義的,而非出於衝動或 不負責任的態度。我們要提醒他們,任何言論都不 應傷害他人,更不應只是為了批評而批評。學生的 聲音應該具有價值,能夠促進學校、個人或社會的 進步。

如果一個言論缺乏意義,既無助於學習,也無法帶來正面的影響,那麼或許它就不值得被說出口。 我們希望學生明白,言論的力量很大,而如何善 用這份力量,是我們應該共同學習與思考的課題。

#### 現時的品德教育是否見效?

我認為,中學階段是價值建構的關鍵時期,而從中學到大學則是一個截然不同 的階段。在中學時,班主任、老師以及校規為學生提供了清晰的指引與框架; 但進入大學後,則不再依賴校規,而是以法律作為行為準則。在中學階段,學 生仍然處於一個被保護的環境中,學校的職責是教育他們,幫助他們分辨對 錯,培養正確的價值觀。

如果我們在學生價值建構的關鍵時期,只是採取「止血」式的方法,告訴他們

什麼不能做,單純依靠規則來限制行為,那麼這並不能真正教導學生如何做決 定。他們將缺乏批判思考的能力,也無法學會如何作出選擇。

我認為學校應該在一個安全的環境中保護學生,讓他們有機會思考不同的事情,並理解哪些行為是可取的,哪些是不適當的。這樣的教育方式,才是最有效的。如果學校希望學生完全不犯錯,那麼確實需要制定非常嚴格的規則,但 我相信,這並不是教育的本意。真正的教育,應該是讓學生在安全的環境下學 習判斷,而不是單靠懲罰來約束行為。

在我第一年教書時,曾感到不知所措,面對許多挑戰時也難免處理得不夠理想。當時,一位同事--也是我中學時期的英文老師--曾經提醒我,要學會分辨何時應該發言,何時應該保持沉默:

"We should never criticize anything without making constructive suggestions." 我們不應該只是一味批評,而不提出具建設性的建議。

這句話深深印在我腦海中,成為我對待他人與工作的準則。我們必須時刻警惕,不應該隨意批評而不提供解決方案。這讓我經常反思: 我是否真的需要說這句話? 這句話是否具備建設性? 如果我們的評論沒有任何實質幫助,那麼不說可能會更好,因為無調的批評不僅可能傷害他人,還可能帶來更多問題,甚 至引發不必要的矛盾。

因此,我想提醒觀瑪的同學們,如今的社會若 要維持和平,需要大家付出極大的努力。我希 望當我的學生離開這所學校時,能夠具備這種 素質--明白自己有能力為社會帶來和平,而其 中一個重要的方法,就是不輕易發表沒有建設 性的批評。學會審慎表達、善意交流,才能真 正推動社會向前發展。

## 為何你會成為一位老師?

## 在你的教學中,什麼是最重要的?

## 你對學生的個人和學術發展有什麼期望?

## 在你的教學中,什麼是最重要的?

李老師認為,激發學生的學習興趣是教學中最重要的部分。正如《師說》中所提到的:「師 者,所以傳道、授業、解惑也。」因此,李老師認為作為一名教師,能夠有效地授業和解惑是 基本任務。為了實現這一目標,李老師希望能夠激發學生的興趣,使他們在課堂上願意接受教 學,並在課後主動學習。

## 你對學生的個人和學術發展有什麼期望?

在學術方面,李老師期望看到更多的學生主動自學,擴展自己的知識領域。她認為,僅僅依賴 學校的教學已經無法滿足當今社會的需求,尤其在人工智能迅速發展的時代,學習新知識變得 相對容易。因此,除了掌握課本知識外,學生在課後進一步提升自己也是非常重要的。

在個人成長方面,李老師希望學生能在中學階段逐漸成熟,以適應未來的社會生活。她期待學 生在生活中有所追求,並在升入大學後擁有更清晰的目標。

## 在參與戲劇製作當中有什麼啟發?

李老師和周老師都是話劇隊的負責老師。但關於戲劇的製 作,她認為自己懂的也不太多,所以一路上也跟着周老師學 習。同時李老師認為參加話劇,除了可以學習到團隊合作精 神之外,也能了解更多社會中大大小小的事,切身處地感受 更多新事物。

#### Why do you want to become a teacher?

When Mr Tsui was choosing his course at the university, he did not intend to become a teacher. Although he majored in science, he did not like calculating. Instead, he is a big fan of football and he likes playing it in my leisure time.

During his Year 4 summer vacation, he went to Poland as a volunteer to help the refugees from Ukraine. During that time, he met many people. Many of them were teachers, who guided the students as a teacher and built wonderful relationships with them. Looking back, he has realized that teachers he has encountered from secondary school to now, have not only taught and educated people but also set aside their status to help others. Their spirit of selflessness has deeply influenced him. That is why he made up his mind to become a PE teacher. He hopes to be like them, guiding and influencing his students.

#### What is the most important thing in your teaching?

Mr Tsui regards teaching with enthusiasm and dedication as essential. Without putting effort in teaching, students will struggle to learn new knowledge. As a teacher, he aims to teach students how to get along with others and express themselves so as to help them get through troubling times. He maintains that a passion for teaching is crucial since all of his students are the future pillars of society. ## Do you have any expectations for our students?

Mr Tsui hopes students are willing to share their thoughts, as this allows them to develop clear expression and strong communication skills. By exchanging ideas effectively, they can develop good relationships with others. Additionally, sharing encourages the development of critical thinking skills and the ability to analyze and evaluate various perspectives, thereby providing insightful ideas. He believes these practices will enhance students' interactions and lead to the meaningful ideas for sharing.

## Feelings about Maryknollers?

Mr Tsui has observed that Maryknollers have developed a strong bond within the school sports team, fostering a deep sense of belonging. Also, they communicate openly and express their needs or learning challenges with ease. In this supportive environment, they feel brave enough to ask questions and actively seek help. Such an open atmosphere encourages mutual understanding and support among one another.

#### Why do you want to become a teacher?

Mr. Law grew up inspired by many exceptional teachers. During his school days, he struggled with English, often teetering between passing and failing. Thankfully, supportive teachers guided him, showingthat learning can – and should – be enjoyable. They introduced him to videos and songs that stimulated his thoughts and significantly changed his perspective on the subject. Conversely, he also encountered discouraging teachers, including one who labeled him as "rubbish" with no future. This motivated Mr. Law to become a teacher who advocates for undervalued students and positively influences their lives.

### What is the most important thing in your teaching?

Mr. Law believes that adaptability and fostering a love of learning are paramount. In today's rapidly changing world, especially with emerging technologies like AI, teachers must stay updated. He emphasizes the need for innovative approaches that incorporate AI elements into lessons to keep the learning experience fresh and relevant. Additionally, he values creating a joyful classroom environment, as a positive atmosphere significantly boosts student motivation. By staying connected with popular culture, such as the latest songs, he makes lessons more enjoyable and relatable, fostering a stronger connection to learning.

## **Expectations for KTMC students?**

Mr. Law hopes that KTMC students will adopt a better mindset and sense of responsibility. He has noticed that many of his Form 4 students feel discouraged about their English abilities, often believing they lack foundational knowledge. He encourages them to take the initiative to try, embodying his life motto: "Perseverance creates magic". He believes that with hard work and determination, remarkable progress is achievable. Additionally, he emphasizes the importance of being responsible and considerate – whether by keeping the classroom tidy or being mindful in communication. These qualities will help them build better relationships in school and in their future careers.

#### What inspires you to be a teacher?

Mr. Mears wasn't actually inspired to become a teacher, but kind of fell into it by accident. When he went to Taiwan and accepted a job teaching in a language centre, he thought that it would only be for one or two years. But then that turned into 3 years, which turned into 4, and eventually it just became his life. So, he became more serious about teaching – getting better teaching qualifications to respect what his career is.

At first, Mr. Mears only wanted to see some of the world and travel a bit, but then he found that he really enjoyed teaching and got better at it. Therefore, over two decades later, he is still teaching.





## Most important thing in your teaching career?

Having an environment that is fun, has jokes but is still serious. Mr. Mears likes having a lot of fun and jokes in his class, but there still has to be a line that cannot be crossed. Like some jokes which are too personal, or language that is inappropriate. But mostly in the lesson, he wants to make it fun and engaging. He often tries to incorporate some surprises and even shocks. It makes the class more memorable. Students don't know what will happen next in the lesson so they will be more likely to pay attention and learn something.



Family. Mr. Mears didn't have a child until he was 47. That is quite old to become a father. Before that, his life was very different. What he cared about was hanging out with friends and travelling and things like that. Once he became a father, his life and what he values changed a hundred percent. Now it's all about his daughter and making sure she's safe and has a good life, and his wife too.

Family is everything now and that's very different from the first part of his adulthood.


