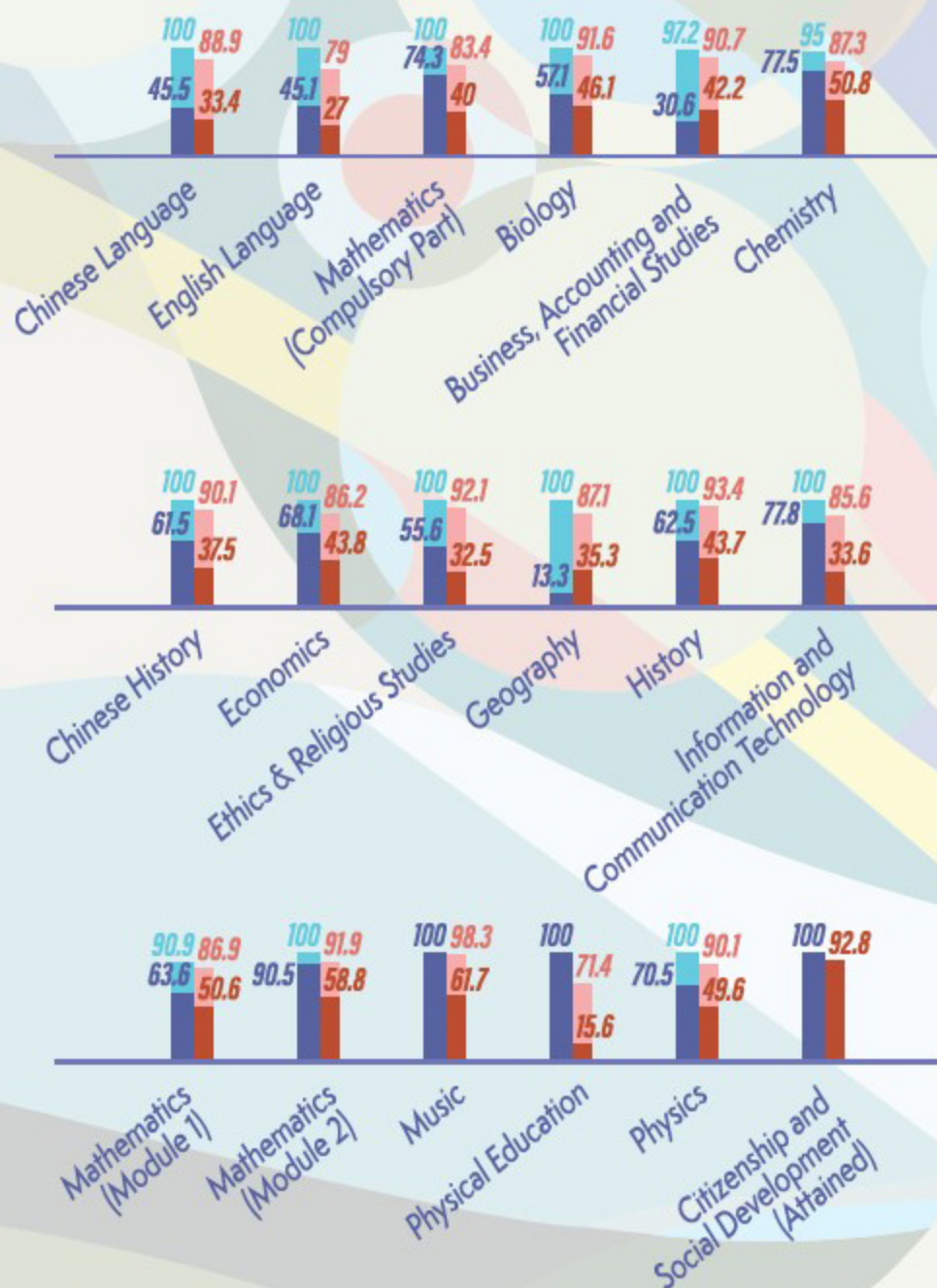

STEAM Education

Through engaging activities, house competitions and elite coding classes, our programme develops critical thinking, teamwork and a passion for innovation, preparing students to thrive in an ever-changing world.



Technology and AI Education

Technology and artificial intelligence are integral to our forward-looking curriculum. Through workshops on generative AI, smart cities and hands-on coding projects, students gain practical experience in applying technology to authentic challenges. Our close partnerships with universities and industry leaders expose students to the latest innovations and ethical issues in technology. These experiences equip our students with the adaptability, vision and technical skills needed to become leaders of tomorrow.



Gifted Education

We recognise and nurture talent through a comprehensive gifted education programme. Using a three-tiered approach, KTMC identifies promising students early and provides them with targeted training, leadership opportunities and access to external enrichment schemes. Selected students benefit from elite classes and participation in programmes such as the HKUST Dual Program and The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education. A key feature of our gifted programme is the Seeds Programme, which cultivates outstanding junior students by developing their strengths and confidence, preparing them to excel as leaders and achievers in their senior years.

Connecting hearts and minds goes beyond the classroom. Our community service and leadership programmes give students hands-on experience in empathy, teamwork and responsible citizenship.
